His honors include the Franklin Mint Award and the prestigious Philadelphia Watercolor Society's Crest Medal for Achievement in the Arts. The Crest Medal Award was previously awarded to Picasso, John Singer Sargent and Georgia O'Keeffe.

Burridge's country studio is located on California's central coast in San Luis Obispo County. His work is featured in many books and magazines, on cruise ships, Starbucks Coffee mugs, Pearl Vodka bottles and on eight commercial tapestries. Along with gallery representation across the United States, his paintings are in collections of corporations, universities and embassies.
